

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

This is a three-way agreement between the parents/carers, the student and the school.

The agreement on the part of the parents/carers: I/We will do my/our best to:

- Ensure that my child is attending the school regularly, is ready to learn by being on time, properly equipped and dressed in the correct uniform.
- Avoid absence from school except in exceptional circumstances.
- Inform the school every day there will be an absence in accordance with the attendance policy.
- Support my child and the school by attending information and wellbeing evenings, parents' evenings and other meetings at which my presence is requested.
- Be interested and involved in my child's life at the school.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour including disciplinary procedures.
- Support, encourage, celebrate and monitor my child in homework and other learning opportunities.
- Support my child's progress at the school.
- Ensure the school is aware of any concerns or successes in my child's life that may affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure that the school is able to contact a named responsible adult in case of emergency.

The agreement on the part of the student: I will do my best to:

- Demonstrate the school values of Ambition, Determination, Excellence, Integrity, Kindness and Respect in everything I do.
- Attend the school regularly, on time and ready to learn with the equipment and books that I need.
- Wear the school uniform correctly and proudly including when I am going to and from the school.
- Complete my class work, homework and exam work to the best of my ability.
- Be kind, respectful and helpful to all other people, both adults and students.
- Make a positive contribution to the life of the school and make the most of the opportunities offered to me such as clubs and support with my learning.
- Look after school equipment and show respect for the school environment and local community.
- Respect and follow the school rules.
- Help to prevent and stop any form of bullying, by reporting it to a member of staff.
- Remember I represent Oakmoor School within the community and behave in a suitable manner at all times.

The agreement on the part of the school: The school will do its best to:

- Promote our core values throughout every aspect of the school life.
- Care for the safety and wellbeing of every member of the school community.
- Communicate any concerns about your child's attendance/behaviour/wellbeing with parents/carers and respond to any concerns.
- Provide a broad and balanced education.
- Ensure that each student achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community.
- Achieve high standards of work, behaviour and responsibility through building good relationships with students and having high expectations.
- Celebrate student success.
- Set, mark and monitor work in accordance with school policies.
- Keep parents/carers informed about general school matters and about their child's progress in particular.
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for parents/carers to become involved in the life of the school.
- Encourage all students to value and celebrate each other's achievements.
- Respond to communication from parents and carers in a timely manner.
